



EVENT NOTIFICATION



On **Wednesday 5th February 2020**, the **Jayco Herald Sun Tour** professional cycling race will conduct a Race Finish for Stage 1 of the men's tour, along with a Race Start and Finish for Stage 1 of the women's tour at **Welsford St, Shepparton**. The men's race will travel from Nagambie to Shepparton via Murchison, Tatura and Mooroopna, and the women's race will travel from Shepparton to Shepparton via Mooroopna and Tatura.

The Tour will again host a prestigious field of riders including many international teams and riders and is expected to deliver a significant economic impact for the state, as well as major national and international media exposure.

To ensure the safety of the riders, spectators and the community, temporary changes to traffic conditions and vehicle access will be put into place. Greater Shepparton City Council will be working with GTR Events, VicRoads, Victoria Police and other Emergency Services to ensure the control of cyclist, vehicle and pedestrian movement for this event is conducted in a safe manner.

Details of the temporary changes to traffic conditions and vehicle access are detailed below:

Road Closures

No vehicle access between these times:

For the safety of the race, **No Parking** will be permitted on these closed sections of road during these times. It is recommended residents park outside of this street if they wish to use their vehicle at these times. For access to local businesses, please use alternate parking options.

Rolling Road Closure

Managed by Victoria Police, stopping traffic only as the race passes through, a Rolling Road Closure operates along the race route between the Start and Finish Road Closures (as detailed above). Delays between approximately 15-30 minutes are expected. A Rolling Road Closure operates by the lead Police cars or motorbikes stopping vehicles at a safe area on the side of the road as the race is approaching. These vehicles then must wait for the race to pass by, and until the rear Police car passes before being able to continue on their way.

The race will be entering the Welsford St Finish Line from Mooroopna direction for both race finishes and exiting towards Mooroopna for the Women's race start. It is suggested to avoid these areas around the start/finish times (noted below under *Event Details*) to avoid any delays.
