**RE: Jayco Herald Sun Tour – Temporary Road Closure – Swan Street
Friday 7th February, 2020**

On **Friday 7th February 2020**, the *Jayco Herald Sun Tour* professional cycling race will conduct a Race Finish for Stage 3 of the men's tour at **Swan St, Wangaratta**. The race will travel from Bright to Wangaratta via Myrtleford, Milawa and Glenrowan.

The Tour will again host a prestigious field of riders including many international teams and riders and is expected to deliver a significant economic impact for the region, as well as major national and international media exposure.

To ensure the safety of the riders, spectators and the community, temporary changes to traffic conditions and vehicle access will be put into place. Wangaratta Rural City Council will be working with GTR Events, VicRoads, Victoria Police and other Emergency Services to ensure the control of cyclist, vehicle and pedestrian movement for this event is conducted in a safe manner.

Details of the temporary changes to traffic conditions and vehicle access can be seen below:

Road Closures:

There will be no vehicle access during the below times:

- **No Parking** will be permitted on these closed sections of road during these times. Please ensure Cars are parked outside of these road closures. For access to local businesses, please use alternate parking options.

Rolling Road Closure

Managed by Victoria Police, stopping traffic only as the race passes through, a Rolling Road Closure operates along the race route between the Start and Finish Road Closures (as detailed above). Delays between approximately 15-30 minutes are expected. A Rolling Road Closure operates by the lead Police cars or motorbikes stopping vehicles at a safe area on the side of the road as the race is approaching. These vehicles then must wait for the race to pass by, and until the rear Police car passes before being able to continue on their way.

The race will be entering the Swan St finish line from Glenrowan and Taminick Gap direction. It is suggested to avoid these areas around the finish time (noted below under *Event Details*) to avoid any delays.
